

Purpose & Description - Signs provided by BSI

- Signage is essential for communication in a shared public space, with a diverse and always changing user group
- Site map sign, by Landscape Architect, helps students and teachers understand the site and provides a record to help maintain continuity when plants and site amenities need to be renovated or replaced.
- other signs, made by students, may be playful, informative, and show active participation with the place
- some signs are temporary made by teachers or downloaded from the BSI web site, printed, and laminated
- some signs are site specific not provided in the design process
