Weekly - trash pick-up & safety check

Seasonal - site inspection (using checklist)

- fall - fall clean up - sweeping, weeding pathways, leaf raking and adding to leaf cage (see leaf cage info)
- winter - sweeping & trash removal, put Schoolyard and OC to bed for winter, tools stored for winter, etc.
- spring - spring clean up - sweeping, weeding pathways, leaf raking, mulching, compost spreading
- summer - leaf cage mixing, weeding, watering, mulching, planting (see student planting bed information)

baseline maintenance & resources

Custodian trash pick up & empty barrels, mow lawns, shovels snow, safety inspection (report to principal)

BPS Facilities repair and refurbish - play equipment, fences, lighting, safety surfaces, tree work, water system repairs, graffiti removal, light bulb replacement, signage, removal of illegal dumping, signage, etc.

BPS / BSI horticultural crew pruning, refurbishing, lawn care, weeding, planting, oversight of summer youth crew (weeding and mulching), annual meadow mowing

Volunteers (school & community) spring & fall clean-ups, special projects and events, tree planting, re-painting play ground graphics as needed
